

Maintenance Apprentice Program

Urick Foundry Company is looking to begin a maintenance apprentice program. The goal of the program will be to develop current employees into multi-craft, master millwrights. The program consists of roughly 6,000 hours of on the job training with 900 additional credit hours of classroom training. The on the job training allows the apprentices to apply their classroom lessons in the field while working closely with a supervisor or another master millwright. The classroom training will include classes dealing with electricity, blueprint reading, PLC's, plumbing, motor control, welding, etc.

We are looking for other local companies to potentially work with to develop a shared maintenance apprentice program. A larger program provides more options for the classroom portion of the training. Cost per student decreases with more apprentices, class location and times become more flexible with a larger class size, and a larger class size may bring more local/state/federal funding to offset the cost of the program.
